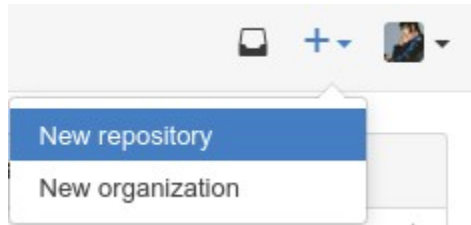

```

git push -u origin master
```

... or push an existing repository from the command line

git remote add origin git@github.com:axilleas/github-essentials.git
git push -u origin master
```
